Then after a short layover we left for Mexico City and arrived at around 1:00pm. Needless to say, we were tired but excited to be visiting Mexico for the first time, and the ministry of our missionary friends. The marriage retreat was Friday night until Saturday afternoon with around eight sessions, some of which were together, and some I taught the men while Beth taught the ladies. We were able to look at different topics like "The purpose of Marriage", The importance of forgiveness", and "The two main ingredients of Love and Respect". It was great to see how the couples responded and even asked questions about how to put in practice what they were learning. On Sunday we were able to visit a couple of the churches the Anderson's have started and then on Monday we were able to see some of Mexico City and the great need for the gospel there. We pray that the Lord will continue to raise up laborers for the harvest in Latin America and around the world.

On August the 6th the country of Bolivia celebrated it's 197th birthday. It's story is similar to many of the countries here in South America that had to fight and pay a great price for their independence. Although Bolivia won its freedom many years ago, it's people are still in slavery, slavery to sin and condemnation. In our new church we had a special day where we recognized the freedom that comes only in Christ and the difference He can make in our lives. At the beginning we sang the National Anthem and had trivia questions about our history and afterwards we had Salteñas, which are the traditional Bolivian breakfast. We pray that the people of Bolivia will continue to come to the freedom that is only found in Christ.
