Yesenia was a young teenager at this time. Thankfully a family friend of theirs, that was attending the church in Pacata, heard what happened and went to get them and took them in. That following Saturday, the lady Esperanza, brought them to youth meeting and Yesenia got saved. It wasn't until the following year when Yessenia gave her testimony that she shared that the night they were kicked out, she had decided the next day to take her own life, and that is when Esperanza contacted her. She spoke about how the Lord had changed her life and where she would be if it weren't for the church. She is now working with the children and discipling several of the young girls in the church. This is why we are praying that the Lord will allow us to help this church to purchase land and have their own place.
