We don't always get to share what the Lord is doing in each of the churches there, but we wanted to share a few of the blessings that we heard about recently. In the church in Pacata, they recently had six baptized and ten that went through membership classes. In Quillacollo, they had their first baptism with three young teenagers taking the step of obedience. Also, in our newest church, they had a special youth activity where they played soccer and then invited everyone to the church, and there were close to twenty first-time visitors. I also got word that after several months of recovery from surgery, Pastor Juan and his family were able to return to Santa Cruz to continue working in the church. It is always encouraging to hear from the men there and see how the Lord is working both in their lives and through them to build His church. Although there is always opposition and difficulty, the Lord is faithful in doing what He promised to do.

## **On the Road Again:**

This past month and the month to come, we will be traveling more than usual, with it being a popular time for missions conferences. We started with a trip to Missouri and Iowa, where we traveled for 27 hours in three days. We are currently in Florida for a little more than two weeks of meeting, then we will be close to two weeks in North Carolina, and finally returning home the last week of March. After that, things slow down a little before we start making our preparations to return to Bolivia. While traveling can be tiring, we have enjoyed visiting both new churches, making many new friends, and supporting churches, catching up with many that have been faithful through the years. Thank you for praying for safety while we travel and the Lord's provision during this time.

## **Spiritual Warfare:**

We have often asked you to pray for the churches and pastors in our ministry in Bolivia. While the Lord continues to bless, Satan does everything possible to hinder and destroy the work He has done.
