Since our return, I have been able to continue to help the men that are leading, in their preparation and also with organizing things at the church. We have been meeting every other Tuesday night, and I have been able to share with them important topics like the danger of apathy, and this past time we were able to talk about the importance of preaching the Bible with its original and true purpose in mind. I was able to help them with how to study a passage, get the main idea, and how to preach it in a way that allows the Word of God to show its true power. (Heb 4:12) We have also been able to plan both a baptism class and a membership class for those who are ready to take that next step. We have four that will be taking the baptism class and nine that will be taking the membership class. We have also been able to see regular visitors at the church, which is really exciting to think about the opportunity to help them also take the next step in their spiritual lives. The Struggle is Real:

I have mentioned several times about the privilege we have to invest in the lives of many different people here that are on different levels in their spiritual journey. Some are considering the decision to follow Christ while others are surrendering their lives to serve Him in the ministry. Both Beth and I meet with these different people on a weekly basis and try to invest in them as much as possible. One of the young men that I mentioned before named Marvin came from a very difficult family situation and for years struggled with bitterness and anger. I praise the Lord that he is now preparing for the ministry and is signed up to take classes in our Bible College this coming trimester. I have been able to meet with him several times and even help him with preparing messages that he is preaching at his church. (Pacata) Right now he is facing a difficult decision to go back to the police academy or not. This decision will affect him for the next year because he would not be able to leave the academy except for a few weekends for an entire year. This is a hard decision because this would be his last year to finish, which was a promise he made to his dad before he passed away. I have counseled him and encouraged him to follow the Lord and His will at any cost but it is still a struggle that he faces. I know that the Lord has brought him this far and pray that He will continue to guide and protect. Please pray for Marvin and the coming year that he won't get sidetracked and that the Lord will use him greatly.
